

RESOLUTION NO.: 77—2023-24

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

2/3 MAJORITY – 24 VOTES

1 The Wisconsin Department of Justice is accepting grant applications for the 2024
2 County/Tribal Law Enforcement Program. Applications must satisfy the requirements
3 found in Wisconsin State Statute §165.90. The submitted plan must be jointly agreed
4 upon by the County Board and Tribal Governing body, and must clearly describe planned
5 activities, objectives, and expected results. The grant award will be approximately
6 \$30,205. The award will be split equally, as in the past, with the Oneida Tribe of Indians.
7 The Sheriff’s Department will be using \$15,102.50 to purchase a drone. The drone is
8 similar to the most recent purchase and far more capable than the previous generation. It
9 offers various high performance sensors integrated into a single advanced camera for
10 easier piloting and an extended battery life. It can be deployed in heavy rain, high wind,
11 snow and extreme cold. The Oneida Police Department will receive \$15,102.50 and plans
12 to use the funds for the replacement of uniforms, officer equipment/supplies and
13 promotional items for their department. A resolution from the County Board supporting
14 the program plan is required. There is no county match required for the grant, and any
15 excess costs will come from previously budgeted funds. This adjustment is for the 2024
16 budget.

18 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Public Safety Committee recommend
19 adoption of the following resolution.

20 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does authorize and approve
21 the Outagamie County Sheriff’s Office to apply for, accept, and expend the 2024 County/Tribal Law
22 Enforcement Program grant issued by the Wisconsin Department of Justice in the amount of \$30,205, said
23 amount to be split equally with the Oneida Tribe of Indians, and,

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does authorize
25 and approve of increasing the following 2024 Patrol line items: Intergovernmental Revenue by
26 \$30,205.00; Supplies by \$15,102.50; Purchased Services by \$15,102.50 as detailed in the attached fiscal
27 note, which by reference is made a part hereof, and
