

MAP OF THE TOWN OF BUCHANAN OUTAGAMIE COUNTY AND STATE OF WISCONSIN.

Surveyors Certificate.

I hereby certify that I have surveyed the Town of Buchanan represented on the within Map under directions of the Supervisors of said Town and in accordance with the Laws of Wisconsin for the establishment of permanent land marks and have set stones in the ground (3 feet long dressed, lettered and numbered as said laws direct) at the Section and quarter Section corners of the square Sections of the United States Survey and also at the Section corners and angles on the rear line or South end of the long Sections of the United States Survey in Township No. 21 North of Range No. 18 South of Fox River, and also have set stones at the intersection of the said long Section lines with the center of the Roads running parallel and near said Fox River except the line between Sections 26 and 25, the Stone is set at the corner of said Sections on the River, and also excepting the line between Sections 21 and 22 where an Iron bolt properly lettered and numbered has been firmly set in the Rock at the corner of said Sections on the River. In cases where the corners established by the United States surveys have been lost and the bearing Trees destroyed and no reliable evidence of the location of said corners could be obtained such corners have been reestablished according to the rules which govern Surveyors in surveying the public lands. The said Town of Buchanan embraces all that part of Township No. 21 North of Range No. 18 East of the 4th principal Meridian which lies South of Fox River, and also that part of the West half of Township No. 21 North of Range 19 East lying South of said Fox River.

Surveyed in the Month of June 1883 with the vernier of compass set 5 degrees East.
