1.0 Introduction and Background

The Outagamie County Department of Recycling and Solid Waste is seeking proposals for a complete refurbishment of a 2016 Caterpillar D9T Dozer (SN REX00456).

Additional refurbished parts or systems are further identified in Section 2.0 below.

The dozer is in use at the Outagamie County Landfill, located at 2009 Holland Rd in Appleton, WI. As of July 11, 2024 the dozer has 12,250 hours on it.

2.0 Specifications

Specifications for the repair include all parts, shop supplies and labor referenced below:

There will be one alternate item which is a complete undercarriage replacement with heavy duty parts. This includes:

- Carrier Rollers
- Major and Minors
- Chains and Shoes
- Idlers
- 12 Month Parts Warranty

Price shall be lump sum to include entire project as referenced in Section 2.0 and the price for the alternate. The price must be all inclusive of any shop fees or environmental disposal charges. The amount paid to the awarded firm for this project will not be higher than the price referenced on the Proposal Form.

3.0 Certification

All work shall be performed by certified technicians to service Cat equipment. Documentation must be provided if requested the County.

4.0 Replacement Components

Replacement components shall be either genuine Cat components, or components authorized by Cat.

5.0 Warranty

Vendor to provide information on the warranty provided.

6.0 Schedule and Liquidated Damages

It will be the Contractor’s responsibility to pick and return the unit to the Department of Recycling & Solid Waste (cost included in their proposal price).

The unit will be available for pickup on or about December 1, 2024 and be returned no later than April 1, 2025. Failure for the Contractor to return the unit fully refurbished by April 1st will result in a \$500.00 per calendar day liquidated damages penalty.

It is the Proposer's responsibility to assure receipt of all addenda, which will be posted online at www.outagamie.org under RFPs & Bids. Upon posting, such addenda shall become part of the RFP and binding on Proposer(s).

Outagamie County reserves the right to accept or reject, any or all proposals, in whole or in part, as deemed in the best interest of the County.

- a. This proposal request does not commit Outagamie County to make an award or to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of a proposal in response to this request.
- b. The proposals will become part of Outagamie County's files without any obligation on Outagamie County's part.
- c. The proposer shall not offer any gratuities, favors, or anything of monetary value to any official or employee of Outagamie County for any purpose.
- d. The vendor shall report to Outagamie County any manufacturer product price reductions, model changes, and product substitutions. No substitutions are allowed without prior approval from Outagamie County.
- e. Outagamie County has the sole discretion and reserves the right to cancel this proposal and to reject any and all proposals received prior to award, to waive any or all informalities and or irregularities, or to re-advertise with either an identical or revised specification.
- f. Outagamie County reserves the right to request clarifications for any proposal.
