



CONTRIBUTIONS: A VITAL SUPPORT FOR THE NUTRITION PROGRAM

The federal Older Americans Act states that any person 60 years or older is eligible for Nutrition Program meal service regardless of income. No fee may be charged for meal service. The Contribution Policy for the Outagamie County Nutrition Program states that eligible participants must be given the opportunity to make a voluntary contribution toward the cost of meal service. Participants must decide for themselves how much they are able to contribute. Participants who are unable to contribute the full meal cost may not be denied meal service. All Outagamie County Nutrition Program contributions will remain confidential.

Participant contributions are important to the continuation of the Outagamie County Nutrition Program. Participants may contribute with the knowledge and understanding that their contribution is being used to support and strengthen the future of the Outagamie County Nutrition Program.
