RE: PROJECT UPDATE – County JJ
County A to STH 47
Town of Grand Chute

Outagamie County, in collaboration with the Town of Grand Chute, is moving forward with plans to improve County JJ between County A and STH 47. The proposed project will reconstruct the existing rural roadway to meet future traffic and development needs and replace deteriorating pavement. The highway will be expanded to a 3-lane urban facility with an 8-ft off-street multimodal trail and on-street bike lanes. A 14-ft two-way left turn lane is proposed as a safety measure to separate left-turning vehicles from the through traffic lanes. The Town of Grand Chute will be responsible for snow removal on the trail. Construction of roadway and multimodal improvements is currently scheduled for construction in 2029.

In addition, the Town of Grand Chute is proposing to extend municipal water and sewer service along the County JJ corridor in advance of the roadway reconstruction project. These facilities will be designed in conjunction with the roadway but are currently scheduled to be installed in 2028 under a separate contract. More information regarding this process will be shared as the design moves forward.

Preliminary corridor planning has been completed and we are now asking for your input on the concepts that have been developed before moving the project forward into the next phase of design. Enclosed you will find preliminary roadway cross section displays along with a preliminary corridor layout. The multimodal trail location is currently proposed on the north side of County JJ from County A through the existing at-grade railroad crossing to minimize impacts to the railroad. However, there is some flexibility on the trail location east of the Gillett Street intersection to the east project limit at STH 47. The enclosed exhibits currently illustrate the trail crossing to the south side of County JJ at the intersection of Indigo Lane in an effort to maximize direct trail access to existing residential properties along the corridor.

We have made every attempt to contact all property owners affected by this project, however, please share this information with your neighbors, tenants, and other interested parties or direct them to our office.

We appreciate your input on the preliminary roadway concepts, and we continue to welcome any other comments or concerns you have regarding this project.
