Yesterday I was notified by Gulfstream that a building we lease to them has a roof top unit/split unit system that is no longer functioning and is causing the areas in the building to run over temperature including their IT server room. When I met with them the space was near 87 degrees. (Typical IT areas are around 67-68 degrees)

I would like to ask for an emergency exemption with bidding this system so we can move forward with replacement ASAP. We don't want their servers going offline or being damaged from excessive heat in this space.
