

RESOLUTION NO.: 27—2023-24

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

2/3 MAJORITY – 24 VOTES

1 The Outagamie County Sheriff’s Office is requesting approval to apply for, accept and
2 expend the 2023 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) grant funds issued by the
3 Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs/Office of Emergency Communications
4 (DMA/OEC). The grant will provide funding for equipment upgrades and advanced
5 training necessary for Next Generation 9-1-1 (NG911). The grant award is \$388,624 with
6 a required 20% match of \$97,156, for a total of \$485,780. The Sheriff’s Office will use
7 these funds to provide training and purchase EVENTIDE recording and VESTA call
8 handling software and equipment. EVENTIDE and VESTA will provide the technology
9 required to handle NG911 upgrades and enhance Police, Fire and EMS (Emergency
10 Medical Services) response to critical incidents into the foreseeable future. EVENTIDE
11 recording software will create efficiencies in reviewing recordings and reducing the time
12 needed to create duplicate radio, phone or multimedia recordings for public release, open
13 records and court proceedings. VESTA call handling is a Motorola product designed to
14 work with the current Motorola FLEX CAD without any interfaces or third party software
15 needed. VESTA technology will seamlessly receive NG911 multimedia data, process this
16 information and share it through FLEX CAD to dispatchers and first responders. The
17 required 20% match of \$97,156 is already budgeted as a 2023 Capital Project.

19 NOW THEREFORE, the following resolution is presented by the Public Safety Committee to the
20 County Board.

21 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does authorize and approve
22 of the Outagamie County Sheriff’s Office to apply for, accept and expend the 2023 Public Safety
23 Answering Point (PSAP) grant funds issued by the Wisconsin Department of Military Affairs/Office of
24 Emergency Communications (DMA/OEC), with a required 20% Outagamie County match, said monies
25 to provide funding for equipment upgrades and advanced training necessary for Next Generation 9-1-1
26 (NG911), and

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does authorize
28 and approve of increasing the 2023 Capital Projects Revenue, Intergovernmental – DMA Next Gen line
29 item and the Sheriff – E911 Hardware/Software, Capital Outlay line item by \$388,624 each, as detailed
30 on the attached fiscal note, which is made a part hereof, and

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to forward a copy of
2 this resolution to the Outagamie County Sheriff and the Outagamie County Finance Director.
