

# ***RESOLUTION NO.: 57—2024-25***

TO THE HONORABLE, THE OUTAGAMIE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN:

***MAJORITY***

1 The Broadband, Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) Program has been established  
2 to provide significant funding to expand high-speed internet access across the United  
3 States and funding is available for unserved and underserved households and businesses  
4 within Outagamie County. The BEAD Program aids to bridge the digital divide by  
5 ensuring that all Americans, regardless of their geographic location, have access to  
6 reliable and affordable broadband services.

8 The availability of BEAD funding is crucial for supporting infrastructure projects that  
9 will enhance connectivity for unserved and underserved households and businesses in  
10 Outagamie County. The purpose of BEAD funding includes promoting economic  
11 growth, improving educational opportunities, and enhancing healthcare services through  
12 better internet access.

14 The Outagamie County Board of Supervisors recognize that broadband connectivity and  
15 reliability is critical infrastructure for health, safety, and quality of life for all community  
16 residents to participate in the full benefits of society and economy, including access to  
17 telemedicine, education, and economic opportunities. Frontier is seeking BEAD funding  
18 for Outagamie County.

20 NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned members of the Property, Airport, Recreation and  
21 Economic Development Committee recommend adoption of the following resolution.

22 BE IT RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does endorse Frontier's  
23 application for Broadband, Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) funding for Outagamie County,  
24 and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Board of Supervisors does endorse  
26 the application of Frontier for BEAD funding to support their broadband infrastructure project in  
27 Outagamie County, and

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Outagamie County Clerk be directed to provide the  
2 attached letter, which by reference is made a part hereof, to the Public Service Commission of  
3 Wisconsin and Frontier which outlines this endorsement and verifies the applicant and geographic  
4 location affected, and include the minutes from this County Board meeting, as well as forwarding a copy  
5 of this resolution to the Outagamie County Development and Land Services Director.
